- i. End of Fiscal year balance \$ 5,744.33
 - 1. Down from opening balance of \$63,839.08
 - 2. Due to: GC funding \$20,000, \$13,000 pay roll-manager and
 - 3. Vernal Pools contractor was paid, but payment from WCB came in after fiscal year. \$27,090 was deposited in September 2021.
