- i. Balance as of Jan. 31 is \$0

- Jean reported on MIU GSA, (Merced Irrigation Urban GSA) coordinated water meeting, includes cities of Merced, Atwater, Livingston and canals. It is one of the three agencies (Merced Subbasin, and Turner Island) representing our water basin.

- b. East Stanislaus Resource Conservation District (ESRCD)

Walley

- Submitted WETA Irrigation Lab grant in collaboration with East Stanislaus and Madera RCD's, as part of larger CARCD grant for CDFA funding. We expect to hear back in March or April. EMRCD is lead administrator for \$50,000.
- ii. Submitted EMRCD individual app, to CARCD to be jointly submitted for WCB funding (yes, this has 10% withholding) for habitat restoration.
- iii. Working on FEMA collaborative application through CARCD for hazard mitigation: drought water quality and floodplain management.
- c. Grizzly Core Projects Updates:

- i. CFP with Sarah Westfall is being handed off to Jeff Borum due to time constraints
- ii. Fully in NRCS system (CART training and LincPass), ready to fill out two apps from Matt for NRCS due early April
- iii. Work on connecting hub and directory of RCS of Valley to begin next week
- iv. Calendar project, and 1-2 checklist for area farmers will begin next week too (when grants are due, listing permitting requirements, etc.)

- e. Ursula reviewed planned use of Line of Credit (awarded) and interest free loan (not yet awarded)

- f. Pending Grant Applications
 - i. DWR Grant was granted, submitted by Jean at MID for \$15,500 for 100 gallon water trailer, with \$500 for project admin.
 - ii. Submitted outline of plans for MID for Round 2 DWR, application for \$60,00 to cover education and stewardship. Due date postponed to May (Bond, Proposition 1, rnd 2)
 - iii. Collaborative WETA Irrigation Lab grant with East Stan and Madera RCD, as part of larger CARCD grant for CDFA funding. \$500,000 requested over three years. Expect to hear back in March or April. EMRCD is lead administrator for \$50,000.
 - iv. Applied to CARCD block grant with other SJV RCD's for Monarch habitat.

- g. Pending Contracts with Partners
 - i. RCPP- came in \$30,000 less than expected; Trina wrote Tom Stein (AFT) on behalf of impacted RCD's to clarify expectations. RCD's are awaiting revised contract
 - ii. \$30,000 line of credit was approved on Feb 8th by County Board of Supervisors.
 - iii. Ursula has submitted application for interest free loan from CARCD for \$20,000.

MSC motion to approve RCPP revised contract language based on East Stanislaus Board vote of approval to fit the timeline. (Shirish/Jean motion), unanimously approved.
